Al-Delaimy, in the August issue of *Environmental Health Perspectives* in introducing new revised ethics guidelines for the International Society for Environmental Epidemiology.

After the adoption by the Governing Council of the ISEE on 25 April 2012, the members of the Ethics and Philosophy Committee are promoting the discussion of the Ethics Guidelines and the identification of case studies, that will serve as examples of the many issues that the environmental epidemiology research community face in daily work.
